Dear Parents and Staff:

As of January 16, 2017, SB 0550 was signed by Governor Bruce Rauner which requires all public and private schools occupied by student in grades preschool through fifth grade to test for lead in water sources used for drinking and cooking. All school buildings constructed before 2000 are required to be tested this year.

Zion Elementary School District 6 is diligent about ensuring our facilities are safe and healthy for students to learn. Part of ensuring a healthy learning environment is making sure our water sources are clean and safe for consumption. The District tested the water at all of our schools, including Zion Central Middle School. Testing results identified lead levels exceeding 5 parts per billion(ppb). In each location, any water fixture showing lead levels higher than the EPA threshold recommendation of 20 ppb have been immediately taken out of service until the needed remediation has taken place.

Please see the chart contained within this notification which indicates locations that tested above Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and EPA guidelines in your child's school. Zion Elementary District 6 is quickly remediating the situation through the flushing of pipes and replacement of fixtures. As the safety and security of our students and staff is our number one priority, though EPA guidelines require remediation for all fixture with lead levels above 20 ppb, Zion Elementary District 6 is remediating all fixtures yielding a lead level above 5 ppb. Once the work is complete, water samples will be drawn to re-test these locations to ensure they meet guidelines for appropriate lead levels.

I want to emphasize that we have clean safe drinking water in your child's school. The areas of concern have been turned off as potential drinking sources for students until remediation is complete. 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All water sources have two samples collected. The first collection at each source is a "first draw" sample. Water collection occurs in first draw samples after sources were unused for at least eight (8) hours but not more than 18 hrs. The second sample is a "flush" sample. Water at that source is collected after 30 seconds of flushing.

*Water fixtures have been temporarily taken out of service due to lead levels higher than the EPA threshold recommendation of 20 ppb.
